Jesus' First Miracle! Encounter: Jesus in the Book of John! Pt. 2 John 2:1-11 March 12, 2023

John 2:11, What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the <u>first of the signs</u> through which he <u>revealed his</u> glory; and <u>his disciples believed in him</u>.

Jesus' First Miracle Teaches Us:

1. Jesus Shows up When He Is <u>INVITED</u>

John 2:1, On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, 2 and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding.

<u>Genesis 2:24</u>, That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh.

<u>Matthew 19:4</u>, "Haven't you read," he replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' **5** and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh'?

2. Jesus Knew His <u>PURPOSE</u>

John 2:3, When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine." 4 "Woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "<u>My hour has</u> <u>not yet come</u>." <u>Matthew 20:28</u>, ...the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Luke 19:10, For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

3. Jesus Moves When We Follow His INSTRUCTIONS

John 2:5, His mother said to the servants, "<u>Do</u> whatever he tells you." 6 Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons. 7 Jesus said to the servants, "<u>Fill the jars with water</u>"; so they filled them to the brim.

4. When Jesus Moves in Our Lives, Others <u>BENEFIT</u>

John 2:8, Then he told them, "<u>Now draw some out</u> and take it to the master of the banquet." <u>They did</u> so, 9 and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though <u>the servants</u> who had drawn the water knew. ...

Luke 2:10, But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people.

5. The <u>BEST</u> Is Yet to Come!

John 2:9, ...Then he called the bridegroom aside 10 and said, "Everyone brings out the <u>choice wine first</u> and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; <u>but you have saved the best</u> <u>till now</u>."

<u>1 Corinthians 11:23</u>, For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, **24** and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." **25** In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." **26** For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. **27** So then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. **28** Everyone ought to examine themselves before they eat of the bread and drink from the cup.
