Psalm 77 Gives Us Seven Journey Stations in a Believer's Life

1. The Believer's TROUBLES

Psalm 77:1, I cried out to God for help; I cried out to God to hear me. 2 When I was in distress, I sought the Lord; at night I stretched out untiring hands, and I would not be comforted.

Psalm 34:19, *Many are the afflictions of the righteous...*

2. The Believer's <u>RESPONSE</u> to the Troubles

Psalm 77:3, I remembered you, God, and I groaned; I meditated, and my spirit grew faint. 4 You kept my eyes from closing; I was too troubled to speak. 5 I thought about the former days, the years of long ago; 6 I remembered my songs in the night. My heart meditated and my spirit asked:

John 14:26, But the helper, the Holy Spirit, who the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

3. The Believer's **QUESTIONS** About God

Psalm 77:7, "Will the Lord reject forever? Will he never show his favor again? 8 Has his unfailing love vanished forever? Has his promise failed for all time? 9 Has God forgotten to be merciful? Has he in anger withheld his compassion?"

Psalm 42:10, As with a breaking of my bones, My enemies reproach me; While they say to me all day long, "Where is your God?"

4. The Believer's DECISION

Psalm 77:10, Then I thought, "To this I will appeal: the years when the Most High stretched out his right hand. 11 I will remember the deeds of the LORD; yes, I will remember your miracles of long ago. 12 I will consider all your works and meditate on all your mighty deeds."

Micah 7:7, Therefore I will look to the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation; My God will hear me.

5. The REMEMBRANCE of God's Works

Psalm 77:13, Your ways, God, are holy. What god is as great as our God? 14 You are the God who performs miracles; you display your power among the peoples. 15 With your mighty arm you redeemed your people, the descendants of Jacob and Joseph.

Deuteronomy 6:12, then beware, lest you forget the Lord who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.

6. The **GREATNESS** of God

Psalm 77:16, The waters saw you, God, the waters saw you and writhed; the very depths were convulsed. 17 The clouds poured down water, the heavens resounded with thunder; your arrows flashed back and forth. 18 Your thunder was heard in the whirlwind, your lightning lit up the world; the earth trembled and quaked. 19 Your path led through the sea, your way through the mighty waters, though your footprints were not seen.

Job 37:5, God thunders wondrously with His voice; he does great things that we cannot comprehend.

7. The PARTNERSHIP of God With His People

Psalm 77:20, You led your people like a flock by the hand of Moses and Aaron.

Isaiah 6:8, Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, "Whom shall I send, And will go for us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me.

The Disciple's Attitude Concerning Suffering

Acts 5:41, So they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for His name.

James 1:2, My brethren count it all joy when you fall into various trials

Psalm 34:19, Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the Lord delivers him out of them all

Christian Suffering Is an Opportunity for Great Joy

Three Ways Christians Suffer:

1. Through Ignorance

Hosea 4:6, My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge

SOLUTION: By Acquiring Knowledge

2 Timothy 3:16, All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,

2. Through Satan's Attack

1 Peter 5:8, Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

SOLUTION: By Submitting to God and Resisting the Devil

* James 4:7,* Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

3. Through Sin

John 5:14, Afterwards Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, "See, you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you."

SOLUTION: Repentance and Confession of Faults

James 5:16, Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

The Power of God Is Available to Deliver

Daniel 3:15, ... But if you do not worship, you shall be cast immediately into the midst of a burning fiery furnace. And who is the god who will deliver you from my hands?"
