Deuteronomy 8:2, Remember how the LORD your God led you all the way in the wilderness these forty years, to humble and test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep His commands. ... 60bserve the commands of the LORD your God, walking in obedience to Him and revering Him. 7For the LORD your God is bringing you into a good land—a land with brooks, streams, and deep springs gushing out into the valleys and hills; 8a land with wheat and barley, vines and fig trees, pomegranates, olive oil and honey; 9a land where bread will not be scarce and you will lack nothing... 10When you have eaten and are satisfied, praise the LORD your God for the good land He has given you. 11Be careful that you do not forget the LORD your God, failing to observe His commands, His laws and His decrees that I am giving you this day. 120therwise, when you eat and are satisfied, when you build fine houses and settle down, 13and when your herds and flocks grow large and your silver and gold increase and all you have is multiplied, 14then your heart will become proud and you will forget the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery... 17You may say to yourself, "My power and the strength of my hands have produced this wealth for me." 18But remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms His covenant, which He swore to your ancestors, as it is today.

How Our Success Can Lead To Failure:

1: Success Makes Us COMPLACENT

Daniel 4:4, I, Nebuchadnezzar, was at home in my palace, contented and prosperous.

2: Success Makes Us Consult The Wrong People FIRST

Daniel 4:5, I had a dream that made me afraid...6So I commanded that all the wise men of Babylon be brought before me to interpret the dream for me. 7When the magicians, enchanters, astrologers and diviners came, I told them the dream, but they could not interpret it for me. 8Finally, Daniel came into my presence and I told him the dream.

3: Success Makes Us Ignore The WARNING SIGNS

Daniel 4:19, Then Daniel (also called Belteshazzar) was greatly perplexed for a time, and his thoughts terrified him. So the king said, "Belteshazzar, do not let the dream or its meaning alarm you." Belteshazzar answered, "My lord, if only the dream applied to your enemies and its meaning to your adversaries!"

4: Success Makes Us PRIDEFUL

Daniel 4:30, ...he said, "Is not this the great Babylon I have built as the royal residence, by my mighty power and for the glory of my majesty?"

Proverbs 27:21, The crucible for silver and the furnace for gold, but people are tested by their praise.

5: Success Makes Us Put Off <u>REPENTANCE</u>

Daniel 4:29, Twelve months later, as the king was walking on the roof of the royal palace of Babylon... 31Even as the words were on his lips, a voice came from heaven, "...King Nebuchadnezzar: Your royal authority has been taken from you. 32You will be driven away from people and will live with the wild animals; you will eat grass like the ox. Seven times will pass by for you until you acknowledge that the Most

High is sovereign over all kingdoms on earth and gives them to anyone he wishes." 33Immediately what had been said about Nebuchadnezzar was fulfilled.

 Daniel 4:27, "Therefore, Your Majesty, be pleased to accept my advice:

 Renounce your sins by doing what is right, and your wickedness by

 Daniel 4:34, At the end of that time, I, Nebuchadnezzar, raised my
