-True Righteousness Is Not <u>SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>

Luke 18:11, *The Pharisee stood by himself and prayed: 'God, I thank* You that I am not like other people—robbers, evildoers, adulterers—or even like this tax collector.

Matthew 5:20, For I tell you that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

-True Righteousness Is Found In The GOSPEL

Romans 1:17, For in the Gospel the righteousness of God is revealed —a righteousness that is **by faith** from first to last, just as it is written: "**The righteous will live by faith**."

Two Indispensable Steps To True Righteousness:

Step 1: Have A Relationship With God Through JESUS

John 3:17, For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.

Luke 19:10, For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.

How Do We Have A Relationship With God?

-Admit To Yourself And God That You Are A SINNER

Ecclesiastes 7:20, Indeed, there is no one on earth who is righteous, no one who does what is right and never sins.

-Agree With God That Jesus Paid For Your SINS

Romans 3:23, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and all are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

2 Corinthians 5:21, God made Him Who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.

-Accept Jesus Christ As Your Savior And Lord <u>BY FAITH</u>

Romans 3:22, *This righteousness is given* **through faith** *in Jesus Christ to* **all who believe**. *There is no difference between Jew and Gentile... 25 God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, through the shedding of His blood—to be received* **by faith**.

2 Corinthians 5:21, God made Him Who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in Him we might **become the righteousness of God**.

Step 2: Live A Lifestyle That <u>PLEASES GOD</u>

Matthew 6:33, But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

-Dive Into God's WORD EVERY DAY

1 Peter 2:2, *Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation.*

-Be With God's People AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE

Psalm 1:1, *Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, 2 but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who*

meditates on His law day and night. 3 That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither— whatever they do prospers.
