- **The Biblical Meaning of Baptism**

Identification With the Death, Burial and Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

(Romans 6:3-8; Colossians 2:12)

- **Biblical Reasons for Baptism**

Jesus was Baptized

(Matthew 3:7; Mark 1:9-11)

He Commanded the Church to Baptize

(Matthew 28:18-20)

- **Biblical Timing of Baptism**

After Salvation

(Acts 2:38, 41; 8:12-13, 36-38; 9:17-18; 16:31-34)

- **Biblical Method of Baptism**

By Immersion: The Greek word "Baptizo" means to dip immerse, dunk,

submerge or plunge.

(Romans 6:3-8; Colossians 2:12; 2 Corinthians 5:17)

By Inference:

"Went up." (Matthew 3:17)

"Coming up out of the water." (Mark 1:10)

"Went down into the water." (Acts 8:38)

By Immersion After the Point of Salvation
