<u>**1** Corinthians 13:12</u>, For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully...

**Job 1:20,** At this, Job got up and tore his robe and shaved his head. Then he fell to the ground in worship <sup>21</sup>and said: "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will depart. The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised." <sup>22</sup>In all this, Job did not sin by charging God with wrongdoing.

<u>2 Corinthians 1:3</u>, Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, <sup>4</sup><u>who comforts us in all our troubles</u>, <u>so that we</u> <u>can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we</u> <u>ourselves receive from God</u>. <sup>5</sup>For just as we share abundantly in the sufferings of Christ, so also our comfort abounds through Christ.
