Ephesians 4:20-32 October 16, 2016

<u>Truth</u>: We all have harmful relational patterns that we need to allow God to change in us, or they will destroy those we love and us.

<u>Hebrews 10:24</u>, And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, <sup>25</sup>not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another...

### **How Do We Spur Each Other On To Save Our relationShips:**

#### 1. Walk In TRUTH

(Ephesians 4:22-24)

- Put Off Your Old SELFISH-SELF
- Renew Your MIND
- Put On Your <u>NEW SELF</u>

#### 2. Walk In LOVE

(Ephesians 4:25-28)

- Don't Lie; Speak <u>TRUTH</u>
- Don't Sin In Your ANGER
- Don't Steal; WORK HARD

## 3. Walk In WISDOM

(Ephesians 4:29-32)

- Don't Harm With Words; BUILD UP
- Don't Grieve The HOLY SPIRIT
- Don't Be Bitter; Be Kind And <u>FORGIVE</u>

#### Do's And Don'ts Of Great Relationships:

	Don't	Do	Reason
1.	Lie	Speak the truth in love to one another	Great relationships are built on truth and trust
2.	Sin in anger	Resolve anger	Great relationships resolve anger quickly and appropriately
3.	Steal	Work, carry your own weight	Great relationships entail both parties pulling their own weight
4.	Speak harmfully	Say the right thing at the right time	Great relationships are crammed with encouraging conversation
5.	Grieve the Spirit	Be led by the Spirit	Great relationships are growing spiritually
6.	Be bitter, angry, contentious, or slanderous	Be kind, tender, and forgiving	Great relationships require mutual compassion and forgiveness
