<u>Matthew 19:1</u>, When Jesus had finished these words, He departed from Galilee and came into the region of Judea beyond the Jordan; <sup>2</sup>and large crowds followed Him, and He healed them there. <sup>3</sup>Some Pharisees came to Jesus, testing Him and asking, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any reason at all?"

# 1. The <u>DEFINITION</u> Of Marriage

<u>Matthew 19:4</u>, And He answered and said, "Have you not read that He who created them from the beginning MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE, <sup>5</sup>and said, 'FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH'? <sup>6</sup>So they are no longer two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate."

# 2. The **<u>DIVERSION</u>** Of Marriage

<u>Matthew 19:7</u>, They said to Him, "Why then did Moses command to GIVE HER A CERTIFICATE OF DIVORCE AND SEND her AWAY?" <sup>8</sup>He said to them, "Because of your hardness of heart Moses permitted you to divorce your wives; but from the beginning it has not been this way. <sup>9</sup>And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for immorality, and marries another woman commits adultery."

# 3. The <u>DEDICATION</u> Of Singleness

**Matthew 19:10-12,** The disciples said to Him, "If the relationship of the man with his wife is like this, it is better not to marry." <sup>11</sup>But He said to them, "Not all men can accept this statement, but only those to whom it has been given. <sup>12</sup>For there are eunuchs who were born that way from their mother's womb; and there are eunuchs who were made eunuchs by men; and there are also eunuchs who made themselves eunuchs for the sake of the kingdom of heaven. He who is able to accept this, let him accept it."

- Ask yourself, "In what ways can I treat my spouse better than myself? How can I serve my spouse?" (Matthew 19:4-6)
- Pursue peace in your home. (Romans 12:18)
