2: Hungry People:
Luka 0.13 He raplied "You sive them compathing to eat"

Luke 9:13, He replied, "You give them something to eat." They answered, "We have only five loaves of bread and two fish—unless we go and buy food for all this crowd." ... 17They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over.

-Hungry People Need To Be Fed Not <u>SENT AWAY!</u>

3: Rejected People:
Luke 7:47, Therefore, I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven—as her great love has shown. But whoever has been forgiven little loves little." 48Then Jesus said to her, "Your sins are forgiven."
-Rejected People Need Acceptance Not <u>REJECTION</u> !
4: Messed Up People:
John 4:17, "I have no husband," she replied. Jesus said to her, "You are right when you say you have no husband. 18The fact is, you have had five husbands, and the man you now have is not your husband." 25The woman said, "I know that Messiah" (called Christ) "is coming. When He comes, He will explain everything to us." 26Then Jesus declared, "I, the One speaking to you—I am He."
-Messed Up People Need Jesus Not <u>JUDGEMENT</u> !
5: Isolated People:
Luke 8:45, "Who touched Me?" Jesus asked.
