Daniel 3:1, King Nebuchadnezzar made an image of gold...5"As soon as you hear the sound of ... all kinds of music, you must fall down and worship... 6Whoever does not fall down and worship will immediately be thrown into a blazing furnace."...12But there are some Jews whom you have set over the affairs of the province of Babylon—Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego—who pay no attention to you, Your Majesty. They neither serve your gods nor worship the image of gold you have set up."

False Images We Are Told To Worship:_____

When The Heat Is On:

1: Don't Be Surprised When Standing Up For God Makes Some People FURIOUS!

Daniel 3:13, Furious with rage ... Nebuchadnezzar said to them, "Is it true, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, that you do not serve my gods or worship the image of gold I have set up?"

2: Don't Be Surprised When You Are Given An ULTIMATUM!

Daniel 3:15, "... if you are ready to fall down and worship the image I made, very good. But if you do not worship it, you will be thrown immediately into a blazing furnace."

3: Don't Let The Outcome Of The Furnace Determine Your FAITH!

Daniel 3:16, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego replied ... 17"If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it...18But even if He does not... we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up."

Exodus 20:3, "You shall have no other gods before Me." 4 "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth... 5 You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents..."

Sometimes God Saves Us FROM The Crisis And Sometimes God Saves Us THROUGH The Crisis.

1 Peter 1:6, In all this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. 7 These have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed.

Four Reminders For The Furnace Of Life:

1: God Is With You In The FURNACE

Daniel 3:24, Then King Nebuchadnezzar leaped to his feet in amazement and asked his advisers, "Weren't there three men that we tied up and threw into the fire?" They replied, "Certainly, Your Majesty."

Isaiah 43:2, When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze.

2: The Furnace Burns Away Those Things That BIND YOU

Daniel 3:25, He said, "Look! I see four men walking around in the fire, unbound and unharmed, and the fourth looks like a son of the gods."

3: How I Handle The Furnace Draws UNBELIEVERS To God

Daniel 3:28, Then Nebuchadnezzar said, "Praise be to the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who has sent His angel and rescued His servants! They trusted in Him and defied the king's command and were willing to give up their lives rather than serve or worship any god except their own God."

4: Faithfulness In The Furnace Leads To GOD'S BLESSINGS

Daniel 3:30, Then the king promoted Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego in the province of Babylon.

1 Corinthians 3:12, If anyone builds on this foundation using gold,

silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, 13their work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each person's work. 14If what has been built survives, the builder will receive a reward. 15If it is burned up, the builder will suffer loss but yet will be saved—even though only as one escaping through the flames.
