Mark 1:17, "Come, follow Me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people."

How Do We Have Good Conversations With Angry People?

1. Speak From A Deep Commitment To CHRIST

2. Speak With Righteous MOTIVES

Psalm 37:6, *He will make your righteous reward shine like the dawn, your vindication like the noonday sun.*

James 1:19, *My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, 20 because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.*

How To Speak With Righteous Motives:

- Disarm Them With <u>HUMILITY & STRENGTH</u>
- Be Motivated By <u>LOVE</u>
- Surprise Them With <u>HONESTY</u>
- Overwhelm Them With <u>TRUTH</u>

3. Speak With Patience And FAITH

Psalm 37:7, *Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for Him; do not fret when people succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes.*

1 Peter 3:15, But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, 16 keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.

Proverbs 16:3, *Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and He will establish your plans.*
