F - FAITH

1 - Don't Live A Jealous Or **ENVIOUS LIFE**

-Don't **COMPARE** Yourself With Others

-Be Grateful For What You **DO HAVE**

-Celebrate God's **GENEROSITY** To Others

Romans 12:15, Rejoice with those who rejoice...

2 - Don't Live Your Life ANGRY WITH OTHERS

James 1:19, ... Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.

Biblical Thoughts On Living Anger Free:

-Don't VENT

-Don't Own Someone Else's ANGER

Proverbs 22:24, Do not make friends with a hot-tempered person, do not associate with one easily angered, 25 or you may learn their ways and get yourself ensnared.
