If God Is For Us, Pt.3

Romans 8:18–30 August 20, 2017

<u>Romans 8:31</u>, What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

Romans 8:28, And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose.

How Can We Live With Hope And Confidence?

• We Know Our Present Misery Doesn't Compare With Our Future <u>GLORY!</u>

<u>Romans 8:18</u>, I consider that our present sufferings are not worth <u>comparing</u> with the glory that will be revealed in us.

Romans 8:23, Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption to sonship, the <u>redemption</u> of our bodies.

 We Look Beyond That Which Is Seen To That Which Is UNSEEN

Romans 8:24, For in this <u>hope</u> we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what they already have?

<u>1 Corinthians 2:9</u>, However, as it is written: "What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived"—<u>the things God has prepared for those who love Him</u>.

• We Patiently Persevere During Difficult <u>TIMES</u>

Romans 8:25, But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it <u>patiently</u>. ²⁶In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us through wordless groans.

Romans 5:2, ... we boast in the hope of the glory of God. ³Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; ⁴perseverance, character; and character, hope. ⁵And hope does not put us to shame...

• We Place Our Hope In God's Faithful PLAN

Romans 8:29, For those God <u>foreknew</u> He also <u>predestined</u> to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. ³⁰And those He predestined, He also <u>called</u>; those He called, He also <u>justified</u>; those He justified, He also <u>glorified</u>.
