Exodus 3:7, The LORD said, "I have indeed seen the miserv of *My* people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. ⁸So *I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians* and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey—the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites. ⁹And now the cry of the Israelites has reached Me, and I have seen the way the Egyptians are oppressing them. ¹⁰So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring My people the Israelites out of Egypt."

> Key Thought: While effort and good works are not involved in our salvation, they are involved in growing our faith and obedience to God's call! (Ephesians 2:8-10)
