Putting On Proper Christian Apparel:

Colossians 3:12, Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with <u>compassion</u>, <u>kindness</u>, <u>humility</u>, <u>gentleness</u> and <u>patience</u>. ¹³<u>Bear with each other</u> and <u>forgive one another</u> if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. ¹⁴And over all these virtues <u>put on love</u>, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
