Mark 12:30, Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.

Definition: Mind (Greek - Dianoia) "the faculty of thinking, comprehending, and reasoning."

A Person Who Loves God With All Their Mind:

-Pursues Knowledge With An Attitude Of HUMILITY

Daniel 10:12, Then he continued, "Do not be afraid, Daniel. Since the first day that **you set your mind to gain understanding** and **to humble yourself before your God**, your words were heard, and I have come in response to them.

Psalm 8:3, When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have set in place, 4 what is mankind that You are mindful of them, human beings that You care for them?

-Seeks To Know God More Through SCRIPTURE

Ephesians 3:17, ... I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, 18 may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

-Connects Our Knowledge Of God With <u>OUR ACTIONS</u>

Romans 8:5, Those who live according to the flesh have their minds

set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. 6 The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace.

-Lives A Life Worthy Of God That Is Filled With GOOD WORKS

Colossians 1:9, ... We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of His will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, 10 so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please Him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, 11 being strengthened with all power according to His glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, 12 and giving joyful thanks to the Father...

-Offers Themselves Daily To The <u>SERVICE OF GOD</u>

Romans 12:1, Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. 2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will.

a) In Your <u>VOCATION</u>

Colossians 3:23, *Whatever you do*, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, 24 since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward.

b) In **EVANGELISM & WITNESS**

1 Peter 3:15, But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, 16 keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.

The Result Of Loving God With All Your Mind:

Matthew 7:24, "Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine

and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.

Philippians 4:6, Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
