Relationships God's Way Requires Uncommon Commitment! #RelationshipGoals God's Way! Pt.4

Romans 12:9-21 October 9, 2016

<u>Hosea 2:7</u>, She will chase after her lovers but not catch them; she will look for them but not find them. Then she will say, 'I will go back to my husband as at first, for then I was better off than now.'

Ruth 1:16, But Ruth said, "Do not urge me to leave you or turn back from following you; for where you go, I will go, and where you lodge, I will lodge. Your people shall be my people, and your God, my God. ¹⁷Where you die, I will die, and there I will be buried. Thus may the LORD do to me, and worse, if anything but death parts you and me."

Seven Keys To Uncommon Commitment:

- 1. Uncommon <u>LOVE</u>: Be A Lover And A Hater <u>Romans 12:9</u>, Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. ¹⁰Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves.
- 2. Uncommon <u>PASSION</u>: Serve God With Passion <u>Romans 12:11</u>, Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord.
- 3. Uncommon <u>FAITH</u>: Don't Stop Believing <u>Romans 12:12</u>, Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.
- 4. Uncommon <u>GENEROSITY</u>: Give Of Yourself <u>Romans 12:13</u>, Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.

 (1 John 3:16)
- 5. Uncommon <u>ENDURANCE</u>: Strength With Hard People During Hard Times

Romans 12:14, Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. ¹⁵Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn.

6. Uncommon <u>BEHAVIOR</u>: Resolving To Live In Harmony And Peace

Romans 12:16, Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited. ¹⁷Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. ¹⁸If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

<u>Romans 5:8</u>, But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

7. Uncommon <u>REFLEX</u>: Respond To Hostile Behavior With Love And Compassion

Romans 12:19, Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is Mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord. ²⁰On the contrary: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head." ²¹ Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
