Reach, Pt.2

Acts 1:8, *But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."*

John 4:1, *Now Jesus learned that the Pharisees had heard that He was gaining and baptizing more disciples than John— 2 although in fact it was not Jesus Who baptized, but His disciples. 3 So He left Judea and went back once more to Galilee. 4 Now He had to go through Samaria. 5 So He came to a town in Samaria... 6 Jacob's well was there, and Jesus, tired as He was from the journey, sat down by the well...*

How To Reach Your Samaria With The Love of God:

-Talk To People Who Aren't LIKE YOU

John 4:7, *When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, "Will you give Me a drink?"... 9 The Samaritan woman said to Him, "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can You ask me for a drink?" (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.)*

-Connect The Physical Need With The SPIRITUAL REALITY

John 4:10, *Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God and Who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked Him and He would have given you living water." 11 "Sir," the woman said, "You have nothing to draw with and the well is deep. Where can You get this living water? ... 13 Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, 14 but whoever drinks the water I give them will never*

thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” 15 The woman said to Him, “Sir, give me this water so that I won’t get thirsty and have to keep coming here to draw water.”

-Don’t Judge People For PAST FAILURES

John 4:16, *He told her, “Go, call your husband and come back.” 17 “I have no husband,” she replied. Jesus said to her, “You are right when you say you have no husband. 18 The fact is, you have had five husbands, and the man you now have is not your husband. What you have just said is quite true.”*

-Focus Your Conversation On The MAIN THING

John 4:19, *“Sir,” the woman said, “I can see that You are a Prophet. 20 Our ancestors worshiped on this mountain, but you Jews claim that the place where we must worship is in Jerusalem.” 21 “Woman,” Jesus replied, “believe Me, a time is coming when you will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem... 23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. 24 God is Spirit, and His worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth.”*

Jeremiah 2:13, *“My people have committed two sins: They have forsaken Me, the spring of living water, and have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water.*

-Point People To JESUS

John 4:25, *The woman said, “I know that Messiah” (called Christ) “is coming. When He comes, He will explain everything to us.” 26 Then Jesus declared, “I, the One speaking to you—I am He.”*

John 4:27, *Just then His disciples returned and were surprised to find Him talking with a woman...*
