God's People Praise Him Continually!  
Summer in the Psalms, Pt. 7  
Psalm 145

**Psalm 145:1**, *I will exalt you, my God the King; I will praise your name for ever and ever. 2 Every day I will praise you and extol your name for ever and ever.*

## Why Do We Praise God Continually?

### For His GREATNESS in Creation

**Psalm 145:3**, *Great is the Lord and most worthy of praise; his greatness no one can fathom... 10 All your works praise you, Lord; your faithful people extol you.*

**Psalm 19:1**, *The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. 2 Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge.*

**Psalm 14:1**, *The fool says in his heart, "There is no God."*

### For His ACTIVITY in Our Daily Lives

**Psalm 145:4**, *One generation commends your works to another; they tell of your mighty acts. 5 They speak of the glorious splendor of your majesty— and I will meditate on your wonderful works. 6 They tell of the power of your awesome works— and I will proclaim your great deeds.*

## **For His GOODNESS to Everyone**

**Psalm 145:7**, *They celebrate your abundant goodness and joyfully sing of your righteousness... 15 The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food at the proper time. 16 You open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing.*

## **For His GRACE and Compassion**

**Psalm 145:8**, *The Lord is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and rich in love. 9 The Lord is good to all; he has compassion on all he has made.*

**Exodus 34:6**, *And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The Lord, the Lord, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, 7 maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin..."*

## **For His GLORY Everlasting Kingdom**

**Psalm 145:11**, *They tell of the glory of your kingdom and speak of your might, 12 so that all people may know of your mighty acts and the glorious splendor of your kingdom. 13 Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures through all generations...*

**Isaiah 6:3**, *And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory."*

## **For His PROMISES**

**Psalm 145:13**, *...The Lord is trustworthy in all he promises and faithful in all he does. 14 The Lord upholds all who fall and lifts up all who are bowed down.*

**Romans 15:4**, *For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope.*

**For His PRESENCE**

**Psalm 145:18**, *The Lord is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth. 19 He fulfills the desires of those who fear him; he hears their cry and saves them. 20 The Lord watches over all who love him, but all the wicked he will destroy.*

**Psalm 34:18**, *The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.*

**Jeremiah 29:12**, *Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. 13 You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.*
