

WEEK FOUR'S MISSION IS TO: **DISCOVER YOUR MISSION FIELD**



Parent Briefing:

In this mission, we will look at several Bible verses that you and your “agents in training” can investigate. After this in-depth investigation, there are several activities that are suited for your agents. This is a time for you to be intentional in teaching biblical truth in order to strengthen your family and your relationship with the Creator!

Mission Objective:

We encourage you and your family to discover your mission field. Remember as soon as you leave your home, you are entering the mission field. We often forget that people are always watching our actions and the way we interact with others. Your mission field isn't thousands of miles away; it's in your backyard! We encourage your family to find a place to serve others. Some suggestions are to prepare a meal for an elderly/sick neighbor, donate new toys to a local hospital, or invite a neighbor to discover 4th at the Creek.

Below are some guided questions to help further your discussion on your mission field, use the investigation material above to answer.

What are different ways that we can help others?

See Philippians 2:4, Why should we help others?

See Hebrews 13:16, What can you sacrifice and share with others today?

How can you be a living example of Christ to everyone you meet?

Agent Debriefing

After discovering your mission field, we encourage you and your “agents in training” to take a picture of the assignment you completed. Post the picture using #CreekCIA. This will allow for the agency to evaluate the picture and give your agents a chance to win a special outing. Be looking for your picture to appear on the Agency's screen during Sunday morning service.

Assignments:

Preschool: The youth group is going on a mission trip to do disaster recovery in Moore, OK July 14-19. This week, pray for the students going on the trip and the people they will be interacting with. Talk to your agent about what a missionary is and does. Have your agent make an encouraging card for the students going on the trip. Bring this card to Sunday school on or before July 6th. Continue to pray for these students and for other missionaries.

Elementary: The youth group is going on a mission trip to do disaster recovery in Moore, OK July 14-19. This week, pray for the students going on the trip and the people they will be interacting with. Talk to your agent about what a missionary is and does. Have your agent make an encouraging letter for the students going on the trip, thanking them for serving God by serving others. Bring this letter to Sunday school on or before July 6th. Continue to pray for these students and for other missionaries.

Youth: Prayerfully think about going to BOUNCE Student Disaster Recovery July 14-19. If you are unable to go, begin praying for these students and the community that they will be interacting with. Pray that the gospel and love of Christ is brought to these people.
