Invite a volunteer to act out one of the emotions from below. Whoever guesses the emotion correctly first, gets to act out the next emotion unless he or she has already had a turn.



(Emotions: happy, surprised, angry, confused, sad, tired)

Our faces often show other people how we are feeling. We will learn that Nehemiah was so sad about Jerusalem that the king of Persia could tell just by looking at him. What do you think happened next?
