

Bible Focus: Daniel and the Lions Den

Verse: With all my heart I try to obey you, God. Don't let me break your commands. Psalm 119:10

Bible Point: We can tell others about God.

Today we learned about how King Darius chose Daniel to rule over all the governors. Some of the other men were not happy about this decision and went to the King and told him he should make a law that said it was against the law to pray to any other god or man but the king. The King agreed and signed the law. Daniel was caught praying to God and had to be punished. The king knew he was tricked by these men but Daniel had to be thrown into the Lions Den. The next morning King Darius went to the pit and found Daniel was healthy and waiting to come out. Daniel told him the Lord had sent an angel to keep the lions from eating Daniel. From that day on the King believed in the one true God!

Supplies Needed:

Paper sack

Yellow and orange paper

White paper

Crayons/markers

Glue



Instructions:

Help your child cut out a circle from paper to make the lions face. Glue the circle onto the paper sack. Help them cut out orange and yellow strips of paper and glue them around the circle on the bag to make the lions mane. Let them draw a face on the lion and help them write "Always do what is right" 2 Thessalonians 3:13 on the bottom of their paper sack.

Strawberry



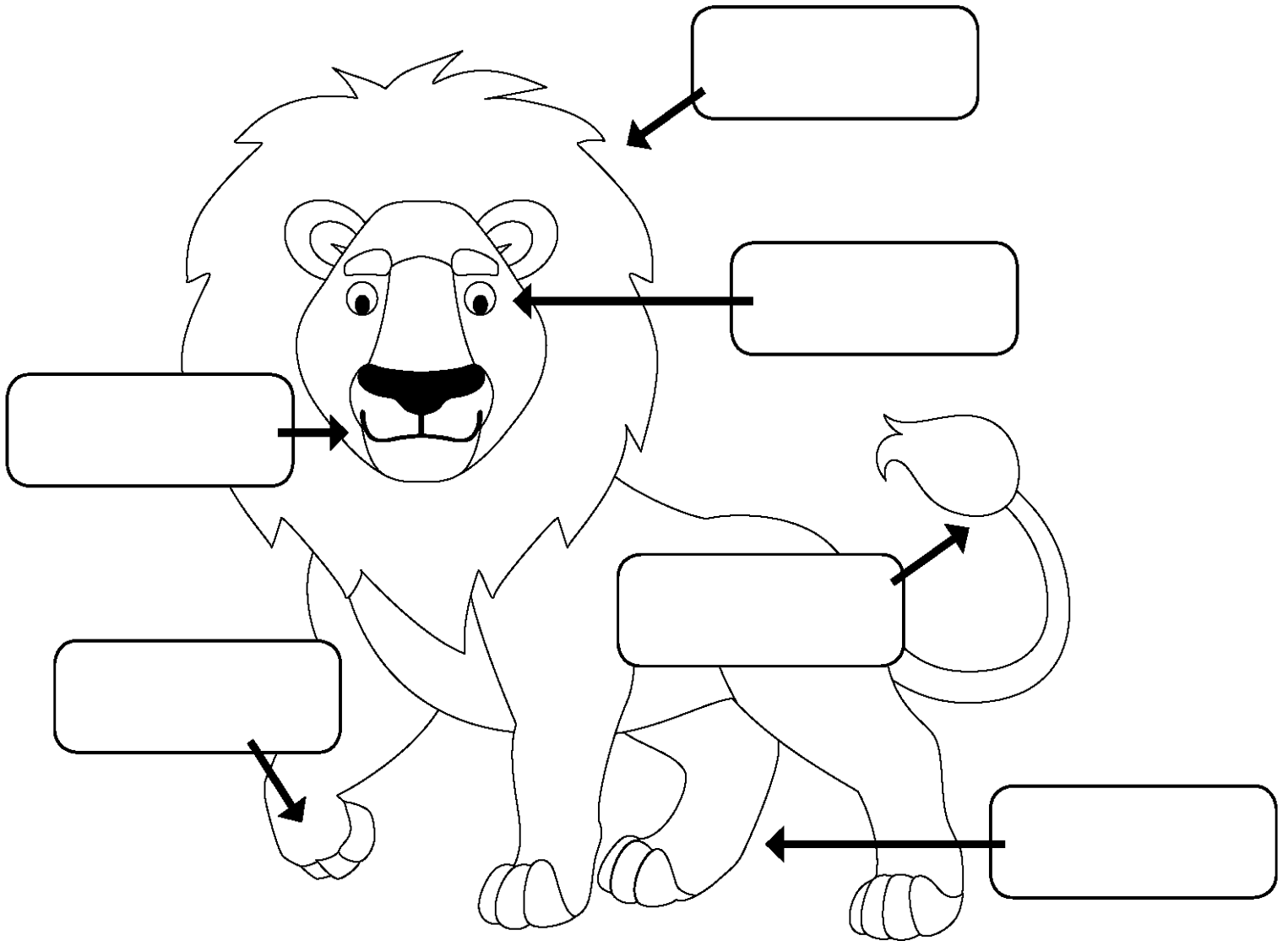
INSTRUCTIONS:
