BIBLE VERSE:

"God saw all that He made, and it was good." Genesis 1:31



SCHEDULE

ACTIVITY:

Talk to your child about the Bible. Talk about how it is God's Word. We read it so we can learn about God and share with others.

Day 6: Talk to your child about what God made on day 6, animals. Use pictures to describe the different animals they made. Ask your child what sound does this animal make. Play with your child by acting like a monkey, dinosaur, doganimals they are interested in and the sillier the better.


PRAYER:

It is so important that you pray with your baby/toddler.

Pray for your child's salvation.

Demonstrate how to pray, folding your hands, bowing your head. Teaching prayer begins during infancy. You may pray yourself or use the following prayer.

Prayer: "Dear God, thank you for this day. Thank you for all the wonderful things you have made! You are amazing! Help us to learn more about you. In Jesus' name, Amen."

While singing with your baby/toddler, rock them back and forth and interact with them. Let them learn that singing songs about the Lord is a wonderful sweet way to learn about God and bond with you.





BIBLE STORY:

Hold up the Bible, "This is the Bible. We love our Bible. It is the Word of God. The Bible is truth." Hug the Bible to your chest. "Let's pat our Bible." Take the baby/toddler's hand and have them pat the Bible. Read the story with enthusiasm to capture their attention.

Babies and Toddlers:

Hold up the teaching picture attached to this lesson or read the story from a Children's Bible. Story comes from Genesis 1.

"On day 6, God created animals! He created animals that roam in the jungle, animals that live on the farm, animals that live in the forest, and animals that live in our homes. God made the animals all unique. Some with a tail, some with spots, some big, and some small.

God saw all the animals that He made and said, 'It is good!' This was on Day 6.

Action Rhyme:

God made the animals large and tall.

(stand and reach up)

God made the animals tiny and small.

(crouch down low)

God made animals that stomp on the ground.

(stomp your feet)

God made animals that run all around.

(run in little circles)

God made animals with great big sounds. (roar)

God made animals with quiet sounds. (whisper)

God made the animals for you and me.

If you could be an animal, what would you be?

TIME TO TALK:

As you change diapers, wash hands, rock, play with, and console your baby/toddler take time to talk about the Bible story.
