On Day 3 God made dry ground with trees and flowers and other plants.

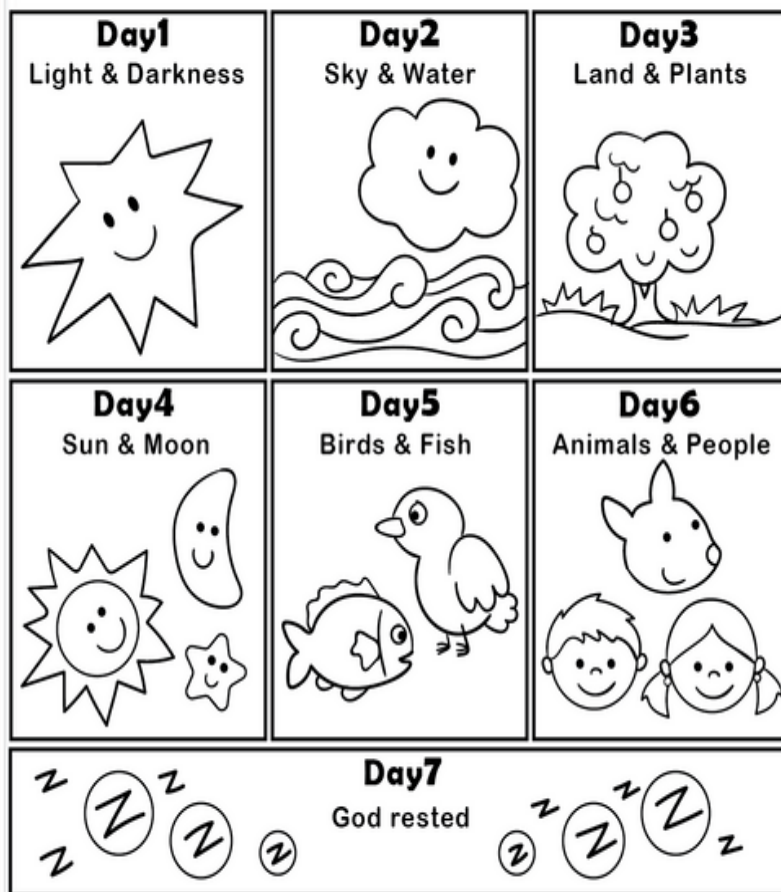
On Day 4 God made the sun to light the day; the moon and stars to shine at night.

When God created the world, He looked at the things He had made. Over and over in Genesis 1, the Bible says, "God saw that it was good."

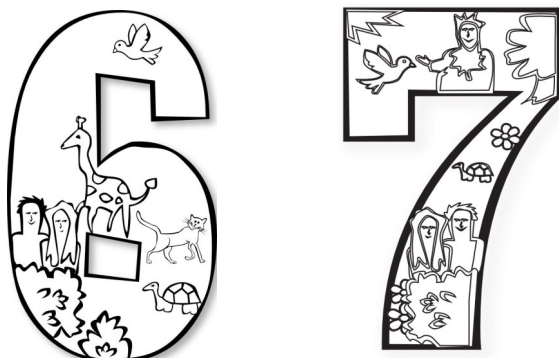
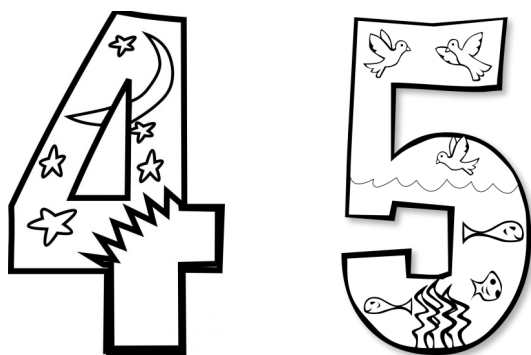
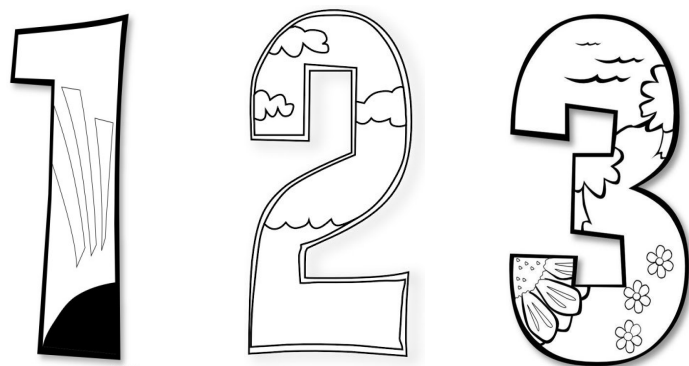
