# Bible Focus: The Ten Plagues...Part One

**Verse:** Give thanks to the Lord and pray to Him. Psalm 105:1

## Bible Point: God cares for us.

Today we learned about an evil man named Pharoah who loved his false idols and city so much he had millions of slaves build his idols temples and buildings. God wanted his people to be free so he sent Moses and Aaron to set them free. God sent them to Egypt to tell Pharaoh to "Let his people go." Pharoah would not let them go so God sent plagues until Pharoah would set them free.

**Crayons/markers** 


White paper

#### **Instructions:**

Today we are going to make a craft to remind us of Pharoah and how he would not let Gods people go. Print out the attached Pharoah headpiece printout and help your child cut it out. Have them color their headband pieces however they choose. When they are done help them cut 2 pieces of paper about 2 inches wide and about 6-8 inches long. Have them glue one piece onto each side of the headband piece. Next measure around your child's head and tape/staple the 2 strips together to wear as a head piece!

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

Today we learned about the first 5 plagues God sent. One of those was frogs!

Lets make a frog to remind us of our story today! Using green paper, help
your child draw and cut out the frogs arms and legs, eyes and some spots.

Using a paper sack., let them glue their frog pieces onto the sack upside
down with the bottom flap facing up. Using red paper help your child cut out
a long tongue and glue it to the inside of the flap. When the glue is dry you
can use your paper sack frog as a puppet!
