

Moses Is Born

BIBLE VERSE:

"Give thanks to the Lord and pray to Him." Psalm 105:1



SCHEDULE

ACTIVITY:

Talk to your child about the Bible. Talk about how it is God's Word. We read it so we can learn about God and share with others.

We are going to learning the story of baby Moses. You will need a baby doll, blanket, and basket. Talk to your child about Moses' mother and how she wrapped him in a blanket and placed him in a basket. He was snuggled up in his basket and placed in the river.

For this activity, you can show your child different objects that float in the water during bath time or play. As they are playing, talk to them about baby Moses.

PRAYER:

It is so important that you pray with your baby/toddler.

Pray for your child's salvation.

Demonstrate how to pray, folding your hands, bowing your head. Teaching prayer begins during infancy. You may pray yourself or use the following prayer.

Prayer: "Dear Lord, thank you for this day. Thank you for loving and caring for all the little babies and keeping baby Moses safe. Help us to learn more about you by reading your word, the Bible. In Jesus' name, Amen."


WORSHIP:

While singing with your baby/toddler, rock them back and forth and interact with them. Let them learn that singing songs about the Lord is a wonderful sweet way to learn about God and bond with you.



BIBLE STORY:

Hold up the Bible, "This is the Bible. We love our Bible. It is the Word of God. The Bible is truth." Hug the Bible to your chest. "Let's pat our Bible." Take the baby/toddler's hand and have them pat the Bible. Read the story with enthusiasm to capture their attention.

Babies and Toddlers:

Hold up the teaching picture attached to this lesson or read the story from a Children's Bible. Story comes from Exodus 2.

"There was a new king in Israel and he was really mean. He wanted to hurt all the Israelite baby boys! But God was more powerful than the king. One day a baby boy was born to a family that loved God. The mother and father were very careful to hide the baby so the king would not hurt him. God helped the baby's mommy to think of a plan. The mommy wrapped her baby in a blanket and placed him in a basket. Then she carefully placed the basket in the river. His sister watched as her baby brother floated along the river. The king's daughter heard the little baby and felt sorry for him. She would not let the king hurt the baby and named the baby boy, Moses.

Baby Moses was protected by God. God is more powerful than any evil, and He had a special plan for Moses. Let's end in prayer thanking God for His protection and never leaving us. He loves you!

TIME TO TALK:

As you change diapers, wash hands, rock, play with, and console your baby/toddler take time to talk about the Bible story.


