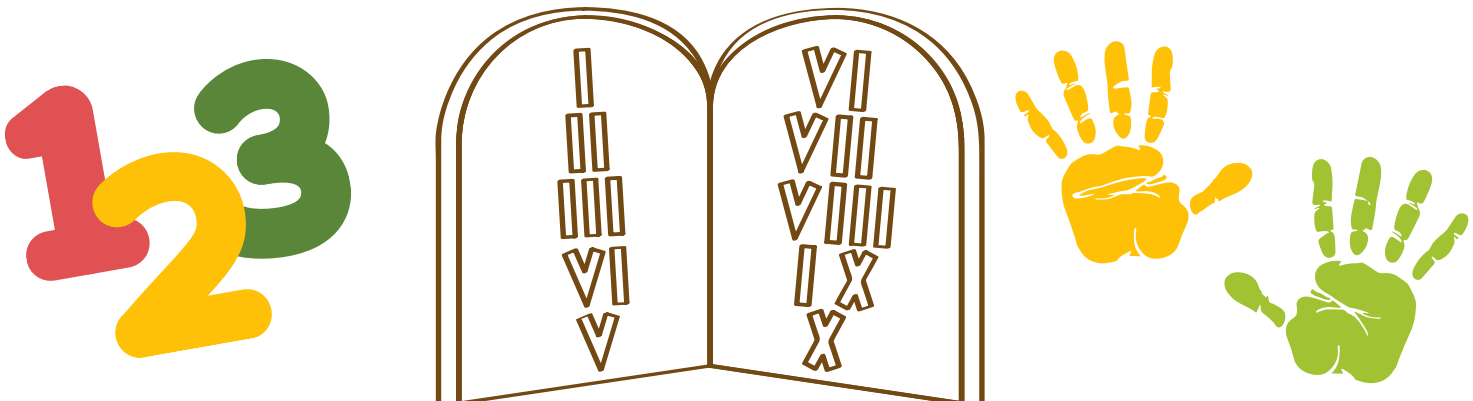
Craft

ACTIVITY:

Talk to your child about the Bible. Talk about how it is God's Word. We read it so we can learn about God and share with others.

Game: Play "Simon Says" with your child or "Red Light/Green Light". You can change Simon to mommy says or God says. Explain to your child that they are only going to do the action when you say "___ says". You can teach this concept of listening through many different listening games. Choose what fits best for your child and age.

Snack: Make a dish with your child whether it be cookies, muffins, or a dinner meal. Help teach your child to follow recipe instructions by getting out measuring cups and the ingredients needed. Tell your child if we don't follow the directions are cookies won't turn out and will be yucky! God gave us instructions (10 instructions) that way we can what is right and pleasing to Him! Without it, we would be yucky too!



PRAYER:

It is so important that you pray with your baby/toddler.

Pray for your child's salvation.

Demonstrate how to pray, folding your hands, bowing your head. Teaching prayer begins during infancy. You may pray yourself or use the following prayer.

Prayer: "Dear God, thank you for this day. Help us to obey your commandments and that they teach us right from wrong. We love you. In Jesus' name, Amen."

WORSHIP:

While singing with your baby/toddler, rock them back and forth and interact with them.

BIBLE STORY:

Hold up the Bible, "This is the Bible. We love our Bible. It is the Word of God. The Bible is truth." Hug the Bible to your chest. "Let's pat our Bible." Take the baby/toddler's hand and have them pat the Bible. Read the story with enthusiasm to capture their attention.

Babies and Toddlers:

Hold up the teaching picture attached to this lesson or read the story from a Children's Bible. Story comes from Exodus 19, 20, 24, 32.

"The Israelites people began traveling for three months toward the new land God promised them. The people arrived at Mount Sinai and God asked Moses to climb up the mountain so they could talk. God gave Moses a special message for the people. God knew it would be important for His people to know how to show their love to Him and to one another, so God gave Moses some rules or laws for the people. These rules were always to teach people right from wrong. Moses was on the mountain for more than a month. God wrote His laws on stone tablets and gave them to Moses. Moses passed along to the people the ten commands God wanted them to follow. The 10 commandments God gave Moses are:

1. Love God with your whole heart.
2. Worship only God.
3. Respect God's name.
4. Remember God's day of rest.
5. Obey your mom and dad.
6. Don't hurt others.
7. Love the person you marry.
8. Don't take things that aren't yours.
9. Always tell the truth.
10. Be happy with what you have and don't wish for other people's.

TIME TO TALK:

As you change diapers, wash hands, rock, play with, and console your baby/toddler take time to talk about the Bible story.
