

Bible Focus: Moses leads God's people across the Red Sea.

Verse: Give thanks to the Lord and pray to Him. Psalm 105:1

Bible Point: God cares for us.

Today we learned about how Pharoah finally let Gods people go but shortly after changed his mind. Moses and God's people had to hurry to get away from Pharaoh. God told Moses to lift his staff when he go to the Red Sea and God helped Moses part the sea so that the Israelites could get away from Pharaoh!

Supplies Needed:

White paper

Blue paper

Scissors

Tape



Instructions:

Using either a white or tan piece of paper, help your child write "God parts the Red Sea" at the top. Cut a piece of blue paper in half and cut strips on each side leaving about 1 inch uncut. Glue down the blue paper (the uncut part only!) onto the white paper and curl up the strips of blue paper to look like giant waves parting the sea. You can then use lego figures, draw out people or whatever you have around your house to act out the sea parting and Gods people crossing!

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Blue Jello

Teddy Grahams, toy figures etc.



INSTRUCTIONS:

Make any flavor blue Jello according to the package (it is recommended to make the Jello Jiggler recipe) and pour it into a square or rectangular pan to mold. When the Jello has set, cut out a strip in the middle to represent God parting the sea. You can use teddy graham figures to represent God's people crossing the sea! When you are done reviewing the Bible lesson you can enjoy a yummy snack with your child!
