Prague Mission Trip 2022

Need: American Native English-speaking adults & teens (minimum age 16 yr.old)

What to expect:

This ministry opportunity is for the Cottonwood Creek family to serve at a multigenerational summer camp in the Czech Republic.

The team from Cottonwood will lead classes, focused on teaching English lessons (you do NOT have to be a teacher to do this), forming relationships, and sharing the Gospel.

In addition to leading lessons, time will be spent forming relationships allowing ample opportunities to share your faith, your testimony and the Gospel.

What's Included:

- Roundtrip airfare from DFW to Prague
- Transportation to hotel in Prague to/from airport
- Hotel accommodations in Prague (Breakfast is included at the hotel)
- Transportation to/from camp
- Accommodations at camp (Breakfast, lunch and dinner provided at camp)
- Lunch and Dinner if/when Team eats out
- Metro tickets for travel and sightseeing in Prague
- Airport Meals if necessary while traveling and no in-flight meal being served (not snacks)

What's Not Included:

- Travel insurance and documents (such as passports)
- Souvenirs
- Extended sightseeing or admission/entrance fees
- Additional time in Prague beyond Monday night, July 27 (if you choose to stay longer/change flight)
- Snacks and drinks purchased

Itinerary:

- Thursday, July 14 Team leaves DFW
- <u>Friday, July 15</u> Team arrives in Prague. The team will be met at the airport and transported to the hotel in Prague in the I.P. Pavlova area. The hotel is located near metro and tram stops with numerous restaurants and dining options in the area. The team will be treated to a dinner with the Czech planning team.
- <u>Saturday, July 16</u> Team training in the morning with the Czech planning team and translators. After training, the entire team will head to a local restaurant for lunch. After lunch, the team will engage in team building and general sightseeing.
- <u>Sunday, July 17</u> After breakfast at the hotel, the team will leave for English Camp. The day will consist of transport, set-up, and getting ready to receive the families attending English Camp.
- <u>Monday, July 18 Friday, July 22</u> Camp schedule will be followed, with English classes in the morning and afternoon, a variety of activities in the afternoons, and an evening program with music and sharing.
- <u>Saturday, July 23</u> Breakfast at camp then clean up and transport back to Prague. Lunch is provided followed by a debrief meeting in the afternoon. The team is free in the evening to explore Prague on their own or with guided activities.
- <u>Sunday, July 24</u> Team will attend church at CBH, then enjoy lunch with the CBH church body. The evening is free for sightseeing or relaxation.
- <u>Monday, July 25</u> Group sightseeing in Prague.
- <u>Tuesday, July 26</u> Team leaves Prague.
