
Session Title: The Last Supper

Bible Passage: Matthew 26:26-30; John 13:1-15 **Main Point:** Jesus and the disciples ate the first Lord's

Supper at Passover. **Key Passage:** Luke 4:18

Big Picture Question: Why do believers share the Lord's Supper? Believers share the Lord's Supper to remember Jesus' life and death and to proclaim Him until He returns.

Christ Connection: At the Passover, Jesus shared His last meal with the disciples before His death and resurrection. Jesus said that His death would establish a new covenant. God's people had broken the old covenant, and God promised to make a new covenant to forgive sins. God forgives the sins of those who trust in His Son, Jesus.




Hard to Remember

Object pic, paper, and pens

Put the Object picture on the table. Tell everyone that they will have 10 seconds to look at the picture and then you're going to cover it up. Then, they will write down all the items that they can remember, or they can raise their hand and you can call on them to tell you what they remember. After they have attempted to write down or tell you the objects they can remember, give them another 10 seconds to look at the objects again. Continue to repeat this process until everyone has written down or told you all the objects.

Say: It was hard to remember all 10 objects after only looking at them once, wasn't it? The more we do something, the easier it is to remember. That's why the church continues to celebrate the Lord's Supper: because it helps us remember what Jesus did for us. Why do believers share the Lord's Supper? Believers share the Lord's Supper to remember Jesus' life and death and to proclaim Him until He returns.
