## 1st- 5th Grade Small Group Lesson

**Session Title:** Disciples Of Jesus Use Their Gifts To Help Others! **Bible Passage:** God gives us gifts to help people (Romans 12:6a)

Main Point: Disciples Of Jesus Use Their Gifts To Help Others!

**Key Passage:** Romans 12:6a

**Christ Connection:** God wants us to use our gifts for His glory. No talent is too small or strange for God to use. Remind the children that, to be disciples of Jesus, they need

to use the gifts God has blessed them with.



Materials: Puzzle Sheet paper and crayons

Print the Puzzle Activity Sheet below. Please give one Puzzle sheet to each person. This activity will help everyone see that no gift, or ability, is too small and that each gift is needed. At the end, the puzzle sheet will be colorful to see that it takes all kinds of gifts and talents to work together. Designate one color per person and have them color the puzzle pieces that they feel they can do on their sheet. And then let the others use their designated color on their friends puzzle sheet to fill-in a space that is not already colored. The center piece is left blank for them to write something they can do for their family, neighbor, church, etc.. and then ask for volunteers to share what they wrote. The puzzle sheets will be colorful to see that it takes the all kinds of gifts and talents that God gives us to help one another and work together as the body of Christ.

Good job! Every piece in the puzzle is important, God wants us to help others, every gift is needed and every gift is important. Think of ways this week of how you can you the gifts and talents God has given you to help others.
