## $\mathbf{1 s}^{\text {st. }} \mathbf{5}^{\text {th }}$ Grade Small Group Lesson

Session Title: Love in Action
Bible Passage: 1 John 3:16-18
Main Point: When we serve, we put love in action.
Key Passage: 1 John 3:18
Christ Connection: Jesus is our ultimate example of showing love in action by dying on the cross to pay our debt. Because of His great love for us, may we serve those around us in a loving action, too.
"Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth."

## Activity

Materials: Notecards \& pens/markers
Give each person a notecard and a pen/marker. Let the group know this is an individual task. Think of a time you showed love in action, or you received an act of love, and write it on the notecard. Once everyone has had a couple of minutes to think of an answer and write it down, take the cards and mix them up. Read each card one at a time

- Would you like to have someone serve you in this way?
- Do you think this would be considered a loving act for someone else?
- If you have served someone or been served, what was that experience like?

Praying for someone, sending a card in the mail, cleaning up someone's yard, or taking out their trash, making a meal, these are some ideas on how we can serve others.
