1st – 5th Grade Small Group Lesson

Session Title: The Fruit of the Spirit **Bible Passage:** Galatians 5:16-26

Main Point: The Holy Spirit changes the way we think and act to be more like Jesus.

Key Passage: 2 Corinthians 5:17

Big Picture Question: Who changes us? The Holy Spirit changes us to be like Jesus for God's

glory.

Christ Connection: When we trust in Jesus, the Holy Spirit begins to change us. Paul told the believers in the Galatian church how to recognize that God is working in someone's life. People who are saved by Jesus become more like Him, and the Holy Spirit gives them power to say no to sin and to live in a way that pleases God.

God's Way Activity

Materials - "My Way/God's Way" paper, My Way/God's Way words (12), Cup

Put the My Way/God's Way piece of paper in the middle of the group.

Print and cut out the words below. Allow the group to take turns pulling a piece of paper from the cup. For each word drawn, the group should read the word, discuss what it means, give an example of someone showing that action, and then decide if the word describes *My Way* or *God's Way* and place the piece of paper in the corresponding column. Allow the group to assist one another in discussing each word. They may refer to Galatians 5:19-23 to check their work.

12 pieces of paper in the cup include:

(<u>My Way</u>: idolatry, hatred, jealousy, anger, selfishness, violence) (<u>God's Way</u>: joy, peace, patience, kindness, gentleness, self-control)


