On April 29-30, 2023, A Taste of Creek 55† was hosted and table displays were set up for each focus area to share information and meet the leaders. Hundreds of visitors filled the atrium both days, some to register as a volunteer, others to express a need for Creek 55† services or to simply learn more about the ministry. The event was a resounding success!

Creek 55† Ministry – How It All Started!

Cottonwood Creek Church offers outstanding programs for children, teens, and adults in our diverse, multi-generational congregation. Last fall several members met with Senior Pastor John Mark to explore the possibility of starting a new ministry with programs to help older adults find and fulfill God's purpose for their 55+ season of life. John Mark was 100% supportive of the vision and facilitated follow-up meetings with senior staff.

Many of the ministries at Cottonwood Creek are lay ministries with a Pastoral Sponsor so the decision was made this would also be a lay ministry. Word spread and soon 18 members had volunteered to be a part of the initial 2023 brainstorming sessions to establish the vision, mission, focus areas and name for this exciting new ministry. Using the data from these sessions, a survey was developed for Adult 3 & 4 Life Groups, with the feedback received providing the top priorities for the focus areas.

Prayers were answered, God touched the hearts of 3 dozen members to volunteer to lead and this group participated in a workshop conducted in April. A solid foundation for the new ministry was set in the workshop and has been refined, enhanced, and launched since then.

The broader Creek 55† mission is to help our 55† members and those in our community find God's purpose for this special season of life. This was shared with our church leaders, and we will continue to strive to stay committed to providing diverse opportunities for those over 55 to find purpose through our church by growing, connecting, serving, witnessing, and establishing lasting Christian legacies.

PURPOSE



We wonder what life will be like and what we will do with ourselves once our kids have flown the coop. One possibility is to renew our sense of purpose. Having a purpose in life means caring deeply about goals you are willing to work toward achieving—often to help others or affect the world in some positive, productive way. Do we need a sense of purpose, or should we just sit back and enjoy life?

Researchers find strong associations between having a purpose as we age and better physical health and well-being down the road. Their findings point to the need to foster purpose in older adults, especially in those who may find themselves adrift after children move away, or post-retirement.

Studies also report people having a higher sense of purpose felt significantly less stress and anxiety after a stress-filled day than those without purpose. Those older adults who were purposeful in helping others said their lives were filled with joy and happiness. Creek 55+ is here to help you find God's Purpose for this season of your life.

Specifically, Handy Neighbors provides home maintenance tasks and light repairs in and around your home, for example, hard to reach light bulbs, replacing smoke detectors, changing A/C filters, installing tub and shower grab bars, and much more!



Handy Neighbors not only serves our church members, but any of your friends and neighbors nearby.

We have lots of volunteers who are anxious to help you with your specific needs. We have helped a few people so far and have the resources to help many more.

Appointments are available on Thursdays and Saturdays. Our visits always include 2 volunteers.

Note: we do not provide any services that require a trade license, i.e., plumber/electrician, nor are we able to perform regularly scheduled services. Think of us like your [neighbor] who is willing and able to help you with those tasks you don't want to ask a family member to do when they visit because you'd rather focus on just spending time together.

Event: Alzheimer/Dementia Caregiver Support Circle

May Meeting

The Caregiver Circle's purpose is to connect individuals who care for adults living with Alzheimer's/Dementia and help them find resources and support.



Our first meeting was held in May and included a presentation by Nora Gravois, a licensed master social worker from the Wellness Center for Older Adults in Plano. She provided a safe place for attendees to share their experience as a caregiver and followed up with a framework for helping them to reach their highest level of Physical and Mental well-being.

The Wellness Center provides preventative healthcare, wellness screening, social and supportive services for well-being, and counseling services for individuals, groups, or groups via Zoom. Nora shared these and other resources to support caregivers for those with Alzheimer's/Dementia.

June meeting

The topic for the Alzheimer's/Dementia Support Circle for June was determining whether it was time for our loved ones to remain at home with additional help or if they needed placement. The Wellness Center's facilitator shared: Our willingness to see what expert care our loved ones need and what respite care we, the caregiver, needs are important to consider when making that decision. Also, our loved one's safety and security should be the top priority for care. In Home and Placement resources and a checklist were shared with the group at this meeting. Kairos #63 was held at the George Beto Unit last month.



The weekend consisted of 4 days of organized talks that bring the inmates closer to the understanding that God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit is the only way to hope for a new life.

There were 36 men who attended this weekend when they witnessed and felt that God's love was available to them.

God accomplished amazing things this weekend. Two Muslims accepted the love shown them, realizing there is only one true God. Two others were leaders of the pagans, and both accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior.

Prayer/Share Saturdays

During this time, 200-300 men meet in small groups (families) to worship, celebrate birthdays and share experiences they had during the week (in the chapel). They share and pray for the Spirit's wisdom and guidance for the following week. It is powerful to see these men pray for each other. You truly feel the presence of the Lord.
