Make a 26-Month Commitment

On Oct. 14 & 15, we will ask individuals and families to turn in commitment cards that represent their intended donation. This is not a binding contract, but a declaration of your intentions, which will help us plan and secure funding.

On Oct. 28 & 29, you may also give a one-time gift in addition to your 26-month commitment. Remember to clearly designate on your check's memo line that the contribution (or a portion of the contribution) should be attributed to Make Room. If you wish to give a cash donation, please enclose the funds in a sealed envelope with your name, address and designation to Make Room written on the outside; these can be dropped in the Prayer and Offering boxes.

You may use a credit/debit card or e-check automatic withdrawal from your checking account.
