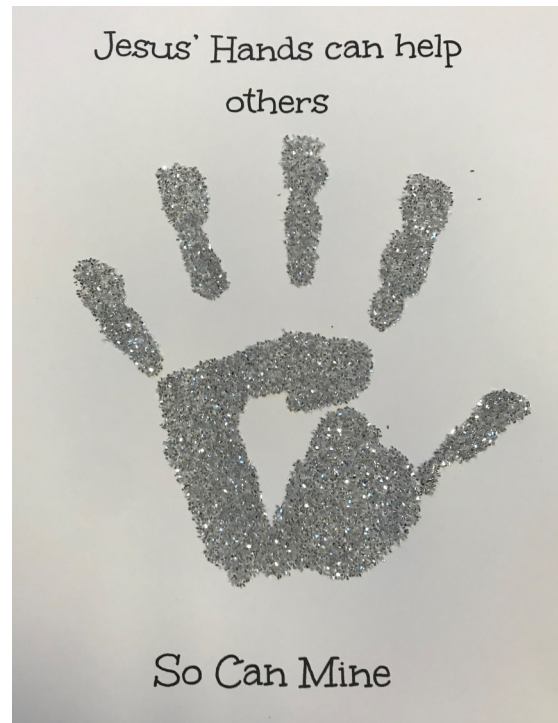
Supplies Needed:

Attached printout

Glue

Glitter

Q-Tips



Instructions:

Print out the attached "Jesus' hands can help others" page. (If you have cardstock that would work best!) Paint your child's hand with glue using a Q-Tip then press it firmly on the paper. Have them wash their hands quickly then hand the glitter to the child and ask them to shake glitter over the glue handprint over the foil pan. Help them shake off the excess glitter into the foil pan and let their paper dry.

Bible Point: We can help others

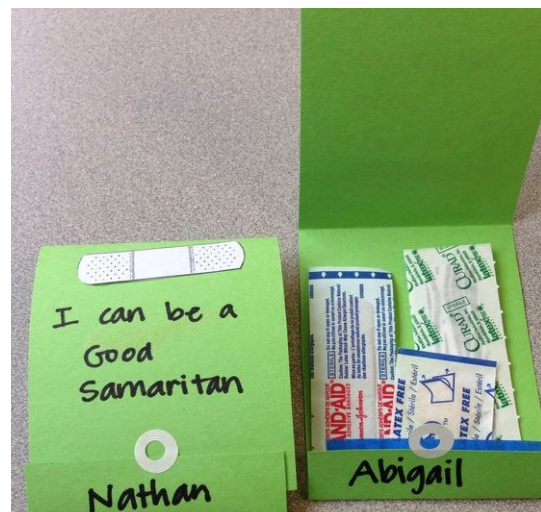
Today we learned about how we can help others. We heard the story Jesus told about the Good Samaritan who helped someone who was injured by bandaging him up, putting him on his donkey and taking him to the inn to help him get better.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Construction paper

Band-aids

Crayons/markers



INSTRUCTIONS:

Let your child pick any color construction paper they want and help them cut it into a long rectangle. Fold from the bottom about an inch up and write their name on the front flap. Next fold the top part down in half to make an carrier. On the front attach a band-aid and write "I can Be a Good Samaritan" They can use this to carry band-aids in so they are ready to help someone if needed just like the good Samaritan did!
