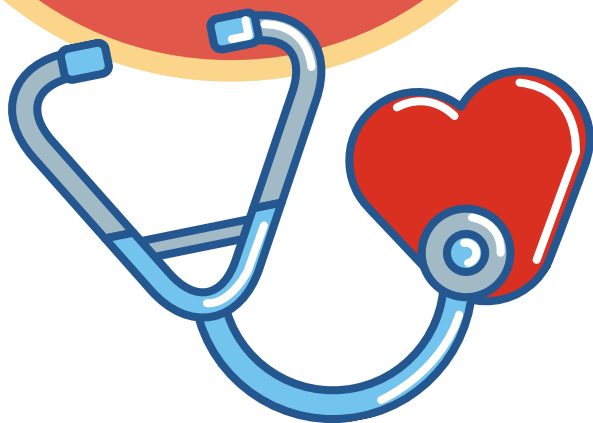

ACTIVITY:

Talk to your child about the Bible. Talk about how it is God's Word. We read it so we can learn about God and share with others.

If you have a play doctor kit bring that out and set it up for your child to play doctor with. You can put out stuffed animals to be the patients. If you have a white coat or a big white t-shirt you can have that out for children to put on to be the doctor. If you don't have a doctor kit it's okay you can easily improvise with what you do have. Popsicle sticks are good to use as tongue depressors. Gauze is fun to have out to wrap an arm or leg, bandages can also be used on stuffed animals. Say to your child, "In the story today, we are going to learn about a Samaritan man that helped a hurt man just like a doctor would. He cleaned up his wounds, put bandages on his body and took care of him."

PRAYER:

It is so important that you pray with your baby/toddler.
Pray for your child's salvation.

Demonstrate how to pray, folding your hands, bowing your head. Teaching prayer begins during infancy.

Prayer: "Dear God, thank you for this day. Please help me to be like Jesus. To help others and be a good neighbor. I love You.
In Jesus' name, Amen."

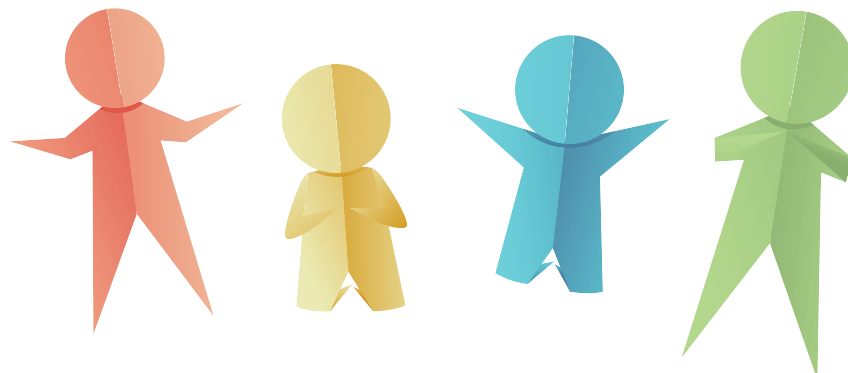
WORSHIP:

PRAISE



BIBLE STORY:

Hold up the Bible, "This is the Bible. We love our Bible. It is the Word of God. The Bible is truth." Hug the Bible to your chest. "Let's pat our Bible." Take the baby/toddler's hand and have them pat the Bible. Read the story with enthusiasm to capture their attention.

Babies and Toddlers:

Hold up the teaching picture attached to this lesson or read the story from a Children's Bible. Story comes from Matthew 7, Luke 10.

"Jesus told a story to teach people to love others. One day, a man was walking alone on a mountain path. A gang of robbers jumped out on him and started to hurt him. They took everything from him! The man was very hurt. Suddenly, a priest walked by and saw the hurt man. He didn't help him and just kept walking! Next, someone from the temple saw the man. They didn't help him either!

The third person was a Samaritan. They were enemies, but he had mercy on the hurt man. Mercy means being kind and forgiving someone.

He gave him a drink, covered his owies with bandages, and put him on his donkey. The Samaritan took the man to an inn. He paid the innkeeper to take care of him. He promised to come back and make sure he was ok. Jesus said we should show God's love to everyone. He said to love your neighbor as yourself!

TEACHING PICTURE



CRAFT:

Craft attached. For this craft, talk to your child about the lesson. Tell your child God wants us to have mercy and be kind to our neighbors. Talk to your child about ways they can be a Good Samaritan too.

Once your child is done with their craft, end in prayer.
