WHAT DOES GOD SAY ABOUT ME?

BIBLE VERSE: I will praise you because I have been remarkably and wondrously made. Your works are wondrous, and I know this very well. *Psalm 139:14*

BONUS VERSE: Even a young man is known by his actions—by whether his behavior is pure and upright. *Proverbs 20:11*

BIBLE STORY: God Made People (Genesis 1-2)

Bible Truth: Being made in the image of God tells us that we have worth and value.

In today's meeting TeamKIDs answered the question, "What does God say about me?" They learned that God created people in His image and that being made in the image of God means each person has worth and value—simply because of whose they are.

In the book of Genesis, we read about the creation of human beings. God said, "Let us make man in our image ... They will rule ... the whole earth and the creatures that crawl on the earth" (Genesis 1:26). On the sixth day of creation, God made the first people, Adam and Eve. (See Genesis 1-2.)

Because God created people in His image, we are created to reflect His glory. Our lives should be representative of God's character—it is only because of that fact that our lives have great value. Our worth is not dependent on people we know or things we do. Instead we are valuable because of the character of our Heavenly Father.

This week remind your child that she is fearfully and wonderfully made in the image of an amazing God. Like a mirror reflects a person's image, our lives should reflect the image of God. Discuss how although family members may differ in appearance, personality, strengths, and talents—all are made in God's image. As you pray with your child, thank God for His amazing creation and ask Him to help your family be a positive representation of their Creator.
