

WHO AM I IN CHRIST?

BIBLE VERSE: Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, and see, the new has come! 2 Corinthians 5:17

BONUS VERSE: So then, each of us will give an account of himself to God. Romans 14:12

BIBLE STORY: Life with Jesus (Ephesians 2:4-9)

Bible Truth: In Christ, we are made alive by grace through faith and we find our identity in belonging to Him.

In today's meeting TeamKIDs answered the question, "Who am I in Christ?" They learned that through faith in Christ, we are made alive by grace and find our true identity in simply belonging to Him.

In the Book of Ephesians, Paul wrote a letter to the church of Ephesus, explaining the concept of salvation to the new Christians there. He explained that all people are sinners, but God sent Jesus to die so that we sinners could be forgiven. Salvation is a priceless gift that cannot be bought or earned. It is only through the grace and mercy of God.

God has a wonderful plan for His children. He wants us all to be forgiven of our sins and saved from eternal death. But those who do not believe in Jesus and put their faith in God will not receive the precious gift of salvation. Instead, sadly, they will die in their sin.

This week remind your child that her identity does not depend on the things she does or the people she knows. Instead, a Christian's identity is defined by a personal relationship with the God of the universe. Any person who believes in Him and follows His plan for life becomes a new creation, forever free from the bondage of sin. Spend time in prayer, thanking God for His amazing gift of salvation, and asking Him to reveal Himself to your family in a way that helps each member see her true identity in Christ.
