

WHAT IS MY PURPOSE?

BIBLE VERSE: So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God. 1 Corinthians 10:31

BONUS VERSE: My dear brothers and sisters, understand this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to anger. James 1:19

BIBLE STORY: A Living Sacrifice (Romans 12:1-2)

Bible Truth: The purpose of our lives is to live a life of worship as we love God above all else and seek His glory, not our own.

In today's meeting, TeamKIDs answered the question, "What is my purpose?" They learned that as Christians, our purpose is to love God and honor Him in every area of our lives. God wants us to give ourselves as a living sacrifice to Him, putting all our effort into following Him daily, while understanding that only through the power of the Holy Spirit is it possible to please Him.

In Romans, Paul explains to believers that God has a wonderful plan for His children. As believers we must trust His plan and follow His will for us. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, our lives can be transformed into a new creation—one whose focus is on God and the things that are important to Him. Displaying attributes such as love, compassion, kindness, gentleness, patience, forgiveness, and thankfulness are evidence of our transformation.

There will still be struggles, difficulty, and temptation. But Christians are commanded, "Do not be conformed to this age." We have a higher purpose, one that brings peace and fulfillment in our identity. We are instructed to be "living sacrifices," or people who daily give up our desires, to pursue God's purpose for us. (See Romans 12:1-2.)

This week remind your child of her vital purpose. As believers, it is always important to keep that ultimate objective in mind so that we have direction and motivation to persevere and remain faithful to our calling. As you pray with your child this week, thank God for His transforming power that works in the life of every believer. Ask Him to help your child live her life in a way that points others to Christ.
