## SCHEDULE

## ACTIVITY:

Talk to your child about the Bible. Talk about how it is God's Word. We read it so we can learn about God and share with others.

Teach your child about sharing by cooking a meal for someone or donating items to an organization that helps people in need. Say, 'In today's Bible story, we are going to learn about a rich man that did not want to share, but Jesus wants us to share. In the Bible, Jesus tells us to do good and be ready to share. We can give good things to other people. Let's pack food, clothing and toys to give to others.'

## PRAYER:

It is so important that you pray with your baby/toddler.  
Pray for your child's salvation.

Demonstrate how to pray, folding your hands, bowing your head. Teaching prayer begins during infancy.

Prayer: "Dear God, thank you for this day. Please help us to share with others. We want to do good things. We love You. In Jesus' name, Amen."

While singing with your baby/toddler, rock them back and forth and interact with them. Let them learn that singing songs about the Lord is a wonderful sweet way to learn about God and bond with you.



## BIBLE STORY:

Hold up the Bible, "This is the Bible. We love our Bible. It is the Word of God. The Bible is truth." Hug the Bible to your chest. "Let's pat our Bible." Take the baby/toddler's hand and have them pat the Bible. Read the story with enthusiasm to capture their attention.

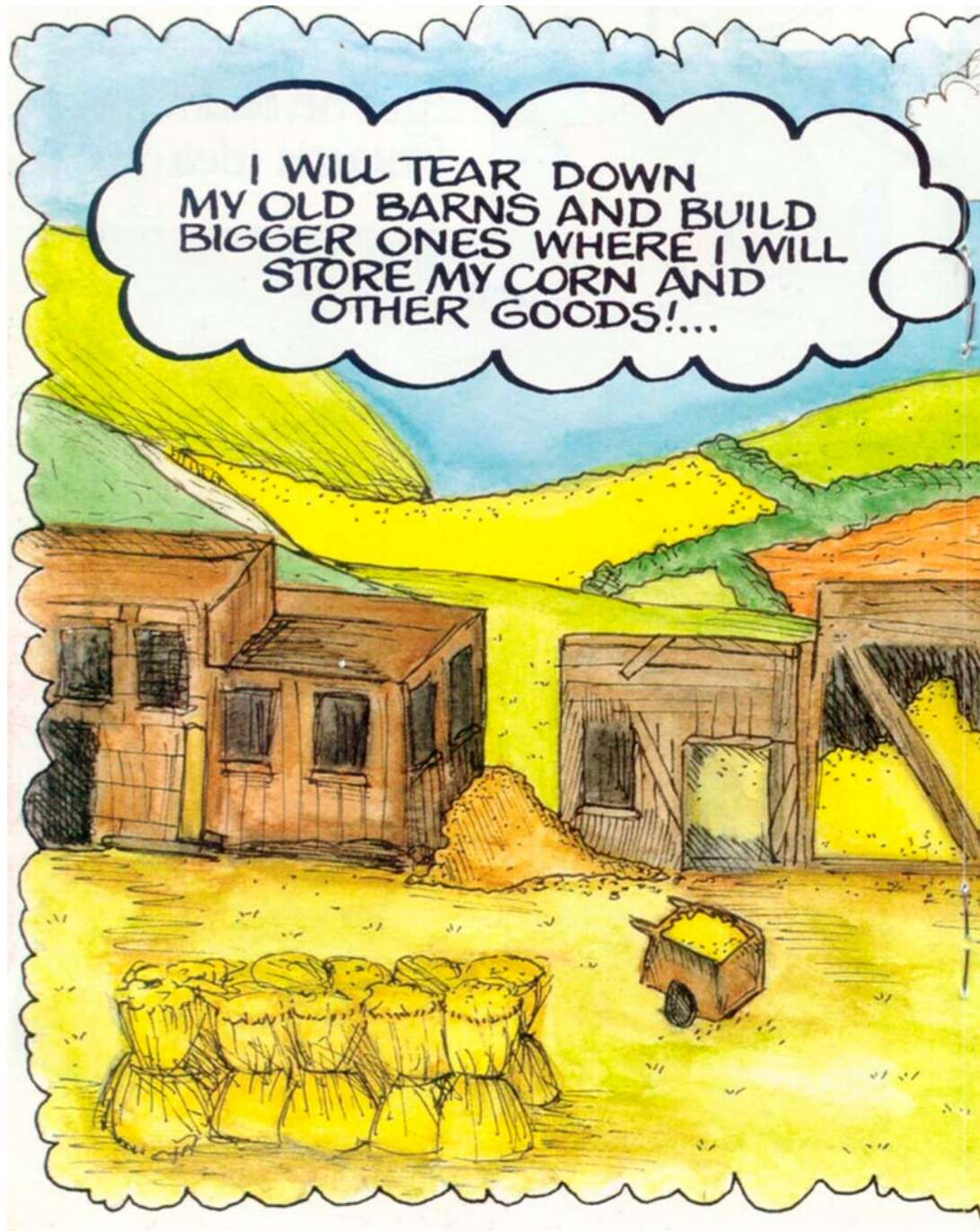
## Babies and Toddlers:

Hold up the teaching picture attached to this lesson or read the story from a Children's Bible. Story comes from Luke 12.

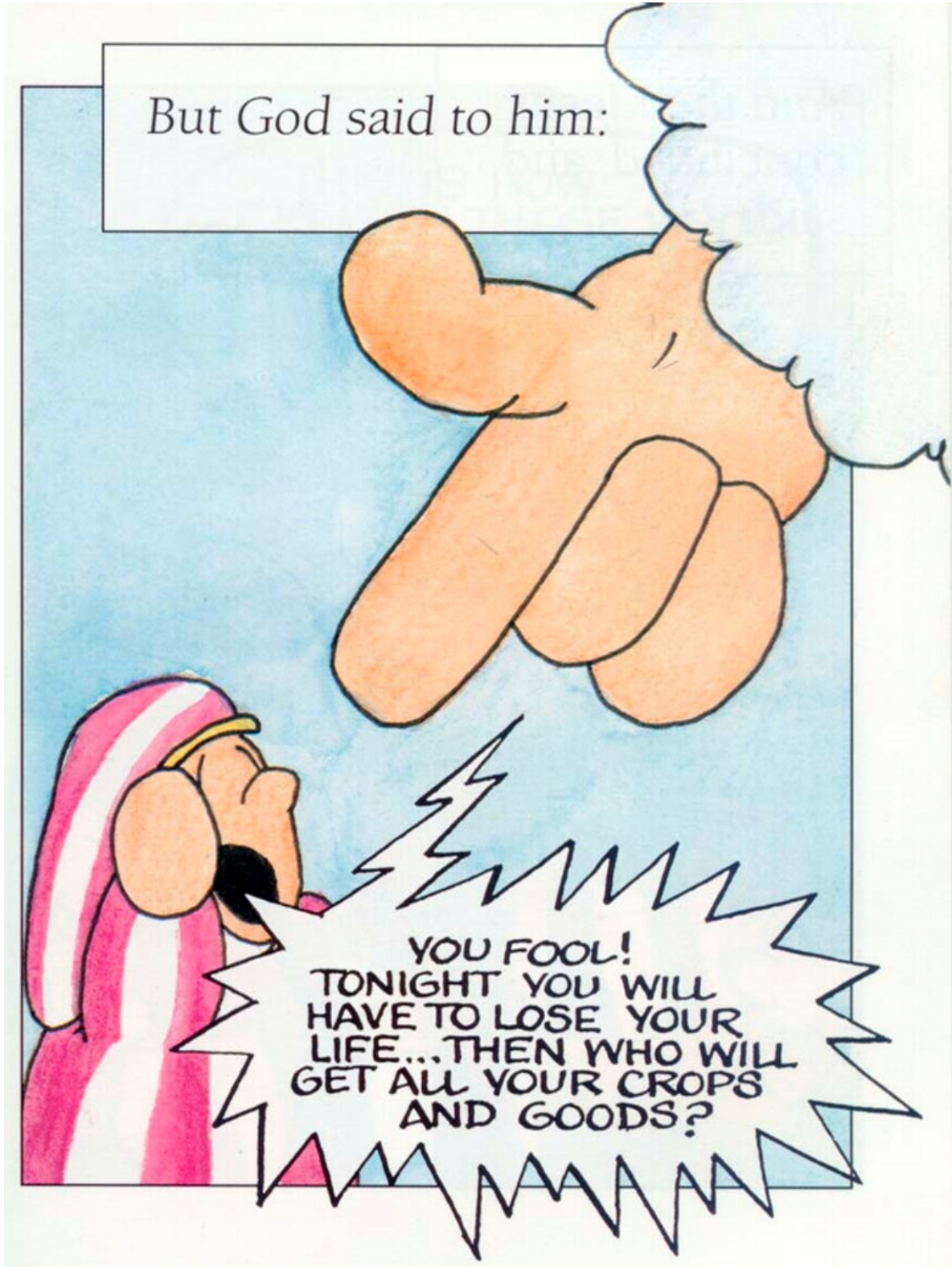
"Jesus once told one of his many par: There once was a man who was very rich. His fields had produced so much that he thought to himself: "Now what should I do? Where can I keep all of my crops?" The rich man said to himself, 'I'm going to do this... I will tear down the barns that I have and build BIGGER barns. That's where I'll store my crops. I will have enough food to last me 10 years!' But God said to the rich man, 'You're a fool! Tonight you will lose everything!'

The Bible says, 'Do good and be ready to share.' Jesus is saying it's not good to save all your money and not help others. This rich man should have thought about who needed his help, since he had more than he needed. Let's love one another by sharing."
