

Craft- Mary and Martha Follow Jesus

For this craft, talk to your child about the lesson and how God wants us to rest and spend time with Him. We can learn more about Jesus by reading the Bible and talking to Him. Once your child is done with their craft, end in prayer.

You Will Need:

- Paper plates (I used colored ones)
- Colored card stock
- Glue
- Brass brads
- Large needle (or other sharp item to poke hole in plate)
- Markers
- Scissors



Directions:

1. Cut out small circles from construction paper or colored cardstock. You will need 12.
2. Number each circle (1,2,3....12).
3. Glue numbers on plate, looking at a clock for reference if needed.
4. Write at the bottom "Always Make Time for God" phrase.
5. Poke a hole in the middle of the plate.
6. Use scraps of colored card stock to cut out hands for the clock.
7. Poke hole through ends of hands and push the brass brad through them.
8. Line up with hole in paper plate and push brad through. Spread prongs on back of plate to hold clock hands in place.
9. Let your child finish their clock by decorating with crayons and stickers.
