
BIBLE STORY

Luke 10:38-42

FAMILY FUN

How did you learn how to talk? How did you learn how to make your bed? Who taught you how to ride a bike? The answer to most of these questions, and others like them, are your parents or other caregivers. You, in turn, are teaching your children and they will teach their children.

There are no lessons in life more important than those dealing with God and Jesus. You are your child's greatest teacher. Set aside a basket of laundry and read a Bible story picture book to your child. Shut down the computer screen and teach your child a favorite Bible verse. Passing on to your children your faith and belief in God will be the most important job you do today.

Bible Trivia. Make a list of Bible questions that are age-appropriate for various members of the family. For example: Who built an ark to be saved from a flood Divide into two teams. Members of teams can take turns asking trivia questions of the opposing team. When the game ends, talk about how important it is to learn from God's Word.
