ACTIVITY:

Role play doctor and a sick patient. Use bandages, gauze, dolls, ice packs, thermometer, toy first aid kit, etc. Tell your child in today's story we will learn about Jesus healing a man who could not walk.

Prepare pictures of animals. Cut them into half where the upper body is separated by the lower torso and the legs. Place all the images on the floor in front of the child. Help them to match the animal images. Repeat the animal name and sound on completion. To make it fun, by the end of the lesson, children can mix and match pictures. For example, see how a bear would look with chicken legs.

PRAYER:

It is so important that you pray with your baby/toddler.

Pray for your child's salvation.

Demonstrate how to pray, folding your hands, bowing your head. Teaching prayer begins during infancy.

Prayer: "Dear Jesus, we praise You because You do great and powerful things. Thank You that one of those things is caring for us and forgiving our sins. Thank you God for making our legs so we can crawl, walk, and jump real high! We love You. In Jesus name we pray, Amen."

WORSHIP:

While singing with your baby/toddler, rock them back and forth and interact with them.

Let them learn that singing songs about the Lord is a wonderful sweet way to learn about God and bond with you.





BIBLE STORY:

Hold up the Bible, "This is the Bible. We love our Bible. It is the Word of God. The Bible is truth." Hug the Bible to your chest. "Let's pat our Bible." Take the baby/toddler's hand and have them pat the Bible. Read the story with enthusiasm to capture their attention.

Babies and Toddlers:

Hold up the teaching picture attached to this lesson or read the story from a Children's Bible. Story comes from Mark 2.

"One day, Jesus went to a town called Caesarea. Everybody wanted to meet and listen to Jesus. The house where Jesus stayed was full of people. There was a man who could not walk. His friends were very kind and carried him to meet Jesus. But the house was too full. They had an idea. The men climbed onto the roof and made a hole. They lowered their friend down to Jesus. Jesus was happy the man and his friends trusted Him. Jesus said to the man, 'Your sins are forgiven.' Some of the religious leaders were angry with Jesus. They didn't believe that Jesus was God and could forgive. Jesus said to the man, 'Get up, take up your mat, and go home.' The man stood up. Jesus had healed the man and forgave his sin. God wants us to come to him and ask for forgiveness too when we do wrong. Only God can forgive our sins and heal our hearts."

TEACHING PICTURE



CRAFT:

For this craft, talk to your child about the lesson. Talk about how Jesus healed the man who couldn't walk and forgave His sins. Once your child is done with their craft, end in prayer thanking God for loving us and forgiving our sins.
