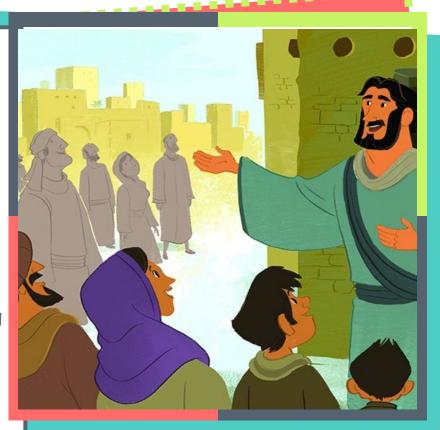
BIBLE STORY

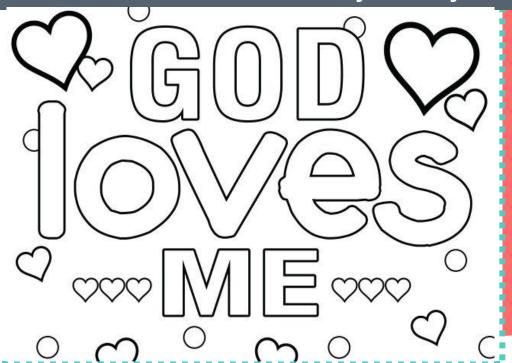
