Bible Focus: The Church Prays for Peter in Prison

Verse: They continued to tell the good news...that

Jesus is the Christ. Acts 5"42

Bible Point: We can pray for people who tell about Jesus .

Today we learned about how the Church prayed for Peter in Prison. Peter was going around telling people about Jesus. King Harold had his soldiers take Peter to Prison.

Instructions:

*Say the words in **BOLD**

<u>Supplies Needed:</u> Black and gray paper Scissors White paper

Crayons/markers

Give each child 4 grey strips of paper and 3 black strips of paper. Have them link them together starting with a grey strip first. Use tape to link them together switching off colors. These chains remind us of how Peter was chained to two of the guards to make sure Peter couldn't escape. Once they have all their links together have them write out on white paper the words "Pray for People" and cut them out and glue them onto the 3 black links. These words are a reminder of how important it is to pray for people. Have your child put their hands through each end of their chain. This is to remind us how Peter was chained in prison. Have your child drop their chains to the floor. This is to remind us how an Angel came to free Peter from prison.
