BIBLE STORY

From 2 Samuel 22:1-3, 50

King David loved God very much. God loved David too.

David talked to God like a friend.

Sometimes David sang songs to God to say thank you or to tell God how he was feeling. "I'm not afraid to go to sleep, God, because You watch over me,"

David sang at night. In the morning he sang, "I will need Your help today, God. I know You listen to me."

At other times, David told God how great he thought God was. We can sing to God too— just like King David!



FAMILY FUN

Today your child learned how King David loved God very much. King David taught the people in his kingdom to sing to God. It is important for us to encourage our children to praise God and Jesus through song too.

Play children's praise CD's often at home and in the car. Sing praise songs with your child while taking a walk or doing a chore. Make up your own tunes and teach your child to sing words of praise such as, "God, I praise You. You are powerful." Sing and thank God for answered prayers. Together rejoice as King David did with songs of praise to God.

SING ALONG.

Pick a time during the week to have a family sing along. Tell each family member to think of their favorite song to sing to God. During the sing-along, take turns leading in favorite praise songs. Between songs, share sentence prayers, thanking and praising God. Have fun as a family singing to God!
