### BIBLE STORY

From 1 Samuel 18:1-4, 20:1-4, 11-31, 35-42

David was best friends with King Saul's son Jonathan. Jonathan gave special gifts to David– a coat and soldier's clothes with a sword, a bow, and a belt.

When Jonathan found out that King Saul was angry with David, Jonathan went to the field where David was hiding,. Jonathan shot an arrow. Then he told his helper to go and get the arrow. Jonathan said, "Hurry and go! Don't stop." David knew this meant the king was angry.

David and Jonathan said good-bye.
They promised they would always be friends.



#### DAY AT PLAY.

Allow your child to invite one of their friends to come and play for the day. Think of fun activities to do together. For example: go to the park, make a special snack, play water games. During a quiet time, read from the Bible the story of David and Jonathan. Thank God for your special friends.

## FAMILY FUN

In today's Bible Time, your child learned about the deep friendship between David, a shepherd, and Jonathan, the son of a king. Your child is becoming more social and is learning to participate with other children in group activities. They are beginning to understand to concept of friendship.

Share with your child how valuable friendships are. Intentionally tell them that you are sending a get-well card to a friend who is sick.

Together, take food to a family you know who is in need. Explain that you are doing this because you want to show friendship and demonstrate you care. Your actions and words reveal to your child the blessings of friendship.
