SCHEDULE

Craft

ACTIVITY:

Use building blocks or any safe stackable items to allow your child to build a house and church. Talk about the different parts of a house or church. Tell your child that we are going to learn about a wise king that wanted to do his very best to build a great temple/ church for God.



PRAYER:

It is so important that you pray with your baby/toddler. Pray for your child's salvation. Demonstrate how to pray, folding your hands, bowing your head. Teaching prayer begins during infancy.

Prayer: "Dear God, thank you for always being with us whether we are at church or away from church. Help us worship and celebrate You wherever we are. In Jesus name we pray, Amen."

WORSHIP:

Sing "Big House".

BIBLE STORY:

Hold up the Bible, "This is the Bible. We love our Bible. It is the Word of God. The Bible is truth." Hug the Bible to your chest. "Let's pat our Bible." Take the baby/toddler's hand and have them pat the Bible. Read the story with enthusiasm to capture their attention.


Babies and Toddlers:

Hold up the teaching picture attached to this lesson or read the story from a Children's Bible. Story comes from 1 Kings 3-4.

"King Solomon asked God for wisdom. Wisdom is knowing right from wrong. God was so happy with him that God gave Solomon wisdom and so much more! King Solomon was wiser than any other person. He also knew many things about plants and animals. People from all over the world came to see him and ask him questions because he was so wise! They were happy to have a new place to worship God! They all said, 'God is good. His love lasts forever!'
