# Activity Option 1

**Bible Focus:** Noah builds a boat.

**Verse: I am God Almighty, walk before me and be blameless. Genesis 17:1**

*The importance of this activity is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.*

## Supplies Needed:

Boat cut out  
Markers/  
Crayons  
Popsicle sticks  
Tape/Glue

\*Say the words in **BOLD**

**Today we learned about how there was a time people on Earth did not know about God. But God could see them. He did not like what he saw. The people were selfish and evil. God wanted to put an end to all people. Noah was a good man. God went to Noah and told him he was going to flood the earth and to build a great ark for himself and his family. God told Noah to bring 2 of every animal with him.**

Let each child color the boat on BOTH sides however they would like! Help each child *fold* the boat over the popsicle stick so that it is seen on both sides! Help the children glue, staple, or tape the sides down.



# Activity Option 2

**Bible Focus:** Noah builds a boat.

**Verse: I am God Almighty, walk before me and be blameless. Genesis 17:1**

*The importance of this craft is to mirror & reinforce what they learned in the Bible Lesson.*

## Supplies Needed:

Folded Paper plate

Brown paper cutout

Animal cutouts

Crayons/markers

Glue sticks

\*Say the words in **BOLD**

**Today we learned about how there was a time people on Earth did not know about God. But God could see them. He did not like what he saw. The people were selfish and evil. God wanted to put an end to all people. Noah was a good man. God went to Noah and told him he was going to flood the earth and to build a great ark for himself and his family. God told Noah to bring 2 of every animal with him.**

Give each child a folded paper plate. Have them color blue on the bottom curved part to represent water. Have them color brown (or however they choose) to represent the ark. Give each child a brown paper cutout and 2 of each animal (panda, giraffe and tiger). Have them glue the brown sheet to the top of the boat (flat side of the plate) next have them glue the animals onto the boat. Once they are done they can set the boat on the table curved side down and rock it to make it look like the Ark is moving in the water!
